



Turf Management Program
~~WARM SEASON GRASSES~~

Application #1 (Jan-Feb)—Pre & post emergent weed control for prevention of broadleaf weeds and annual crabgrass. Spot application for grassy weed control..

Application # 2 (Mar-Apr)—High nitrogen fertilizer for timely lush green up of the turf. 2nd application of pre & post emergent for weed control. Grassy weed control as needed.

Application #3 (May)—Warmer temperatures at this time demand a granular controlled release fertilizer for color enhancement. Also, we apply a grassy weed control application.

Application #4 (June-July)— 100% slow release fertilizer to maintain the color and supply nutrients to the root system. Again, spot treatment is applied as needed for grassy and broadleaf weed control. Proper mowing is crucial at this point, and water aids in activation of this fertilizer.

Application # 5 (Aug)—End of summer season requires a granular controlled release fertilizer mix to maintain the color established from early summer. Raising of the cutting height is needed for warm season grass at this point.

Application # 6 (Sept) – An application of both a pre & post emergent for weed control is applied. This is the time when winter annual weeds germinate and this application will help prevent the germination process.

Application #7 (Nov-Dec)— The second application of both a pre & post emergent for weed control is applied to your lawn. Lime can be added to help balance PH level in order to allow the soil to more efficiently absorb and use fertilizer. Lime is applied only if the soil needs it. Also spot treatment for grassy and broad leaf is applied for weed control.
